Rules and Consequences for Choir Tour

In order for us to have a successful, quality tour, we must adhere to all the rules and regulations of Farmington High School.

Possession, use and distribution of chemicals, smoking, weapons policy

We will adhere to all school policies relating to possession, use and distribution of chemicals, smoking, and the weapons policy. We will be following all policies laid out in the student handbook (pg. 32-34). Please understand there is zero tolerance for using any chemicals or possessing any weapons while on choir tour and the student will be sent immediately home at the student/parents' expense.

Room Assignments

In order for students to be healthy, they must be well rested on our choir tour. Students will be in their assigned rooms no later than **11:00pm** each night. Chaperones will check each individual room and physically see each student in the room. We must have strict policies in place to ensure students are comfortable and safe within their rooms. Students are not allowed to have visitors that are not on our tour unless it is approved by Mrs. Dimich. Students also are not allowed to stay anywhere else except their assigned rooms while on tour with the choir.

Student Conduct and Dress

When on choir tour, we are representatives of Farmington High School, Farmington, MN and the state of Minnesota. We will conduct ourselves with respect towards ourselves, others, and each place we visit. The use of inappropriate language, provocative or inappropriate clothing, or disrespect of chaperones and peers is strictly prohibited. We have specific dress requirements for the following places.
