Kick off your time in Puerto Rico with a walking tour of Old San Juan, one of the New World's oldest living cities. Visit the Castillo de San Cristóbal, a Spanish fort built by Spain to protect against land-based attacks on the city of San Juan. With three levels and extensive outer defences, the fortification took over 150 years to complete. Board a motorcoach and travel to "the Pearl of the South," Ponce, Puerto Rico's second largest city! Ponce was founded in 1692 by Juan Ponce de León's great-grandson, Loíza Ponce de León.
